EMERGENCY ORDER ENFORCING MANDATE


This cause came on to be heard upon the oral emergency motion to enforce mandate brought by the guardian, and with oral notice given to the Department of Children and Families, it is

ORDERED, as follows:

1. The Department of Children and Families is hereby restrained from taking possession of Theresa Marie Schiavo or removing her from the Hospice Woodside facility, administering nutrition or hydration artificially, or otherwise interfering with this Court's final judgment, or causing the same to occur, and all those persons acting in concert with DCF are hereby also restrained.

2. That each and every and singular Sheriff of the State of Florida are hereby directed to take such actions or action as is necessary to enforce the provisions hereof.

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard at hearing on March 24, 2005, upon the emergency motion to vacate per Rule 9.310 brought by the guardian. The Department of Children and Families (DCF) was represented by Keith J. Ganobsik, Esq, the Guardian was represented by George J. Felos, Esq, and Mr. and Mrs. Schindler were represented by David C. Gibbs, III, Esq. After hearing legal argument and being duly advised in the premises, the Court ruled that the executive and judicial branches of government are separate but equal and that the executive branch is not superior in the area of judicial matters. *Bush v Schiavo*, 885 So.2d 321 (Fla. 2004). It is therefore

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the automatic stay of this Court's March 23, 2005 Order to Enforce Mandate, occasioned by the appeal thereof

by the Department of Children and Families, is hereby VACATED, and the restraining order is in full force and effect.
